


How are we in December already?

2023 CONSECRATION SUNDAY FINAL REPORT

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Total # of giving units we have on record: 53

DIFFERENCE

Total # of giving units that completed as Estimate of Giving Cards this year: 31

Total #of these giving units that increased their financial commitment above their last year's amount: 24

The giving units present on Consecration Sunday to fill out Estimate of Giving Cards committed a total of \$75,892.00.

Based on last year's giving, we can expect to receive another \$42,609.00 from members who give regularly on record and are active but were not present or chose not to fill out a card.

Other income from past giving records (cash, savings, rentals, and fees) totaled \$57,000.00 and were also added.

So the total anticipated budget for 2024 will be \$175,501.00

The total income for our general operating budget during the last twelve months from pledged givers was \$104,500.00. On Consecration Sunday our operating budget income increased by \$14,001.00 and the new total expected for operating budget for next year from this giving is \$118,501.00! This represents an increase over the previous year actual giving of 13.4%!

Support Your Church through Your IRA Required Minimum Distribution

Are you over the age of, or approaching 70-1/2 and must take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) annually from your traditional IRA? This Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) is taxed as ordinary income.

Why not consider turning some or all of your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) into a <u>Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)</u> to your Church to fulfill all or part of your annual contribution, and/or for a special project? In so doing, the amount donated is excluded from your taxable income keeping your taxable income lower.

Qualified Charitable Distributions don't require you to itemize. Therefore, you may choose to take advantage of the higher standard deduction and still use a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) for charitable giving.

To make a Qualified Charitable Distribution, certain requirements must be met:

- You must be 70½ or older
- The maximum annual amount that can qualify for a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) is \$100,000. Your spouse may also be able to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from his or her own IRA in the same tax year for up to \$100,000.
- Your Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) can be made to one or more charities, such as the church, or IHN, or any qualified charity. You may also stipulate how you wish your Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) be used by the organization you are supporting such as the Food Pantry or the Youth Program.
- For a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) to count toward your current year's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), the funds must come out of your IRA by your Required Minimum Distribution deadline, generally December 31. However, it is wise to not wait to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) until the deadline date since the IRA Custodian needs time to process your request.

Tax reporting

A <u>Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)</u> is reported as a normal distribution on IRS Form 1099-R for any non-inherited IRAs. While the Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) amount is not taxed, you may not then claim the distribution as a charitable tax deduction.

To accompany your tax form, you will need a letter from the charity detailing that the gift came directly from your IRA custodian and that you received no goods or services in exchange for your gift.

Next steps?

Consult your tax or legal advisor. Then notify your IRA custodian you wish to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). The Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) must be sent directly to the charity by the IRA Custodian. If it is sent to you, it will be considered taxable income.
