Pastor's Message

JULY 2023 Our church council joins the councils of our LSIM partner congregations this month in retreat at St. John's Vandalia on Saturday, July 22 from 9 -11:30 AM. We will refamiliarize ourselves with LSIM's purpose and mission and discuss collaborative ministry for the near future. After the retreat ends, I expect to spend some time with the council debriefing the call process. (Our Bishop and her staff will also be meeting with the call committee and council this month to review the situation.)

As you know, our candidate withdrew her name from consideration last week. This was disappointing and surprising as she seemed excited about doing ministry in this congregation and community after her first interview. But receiving a different "vibe" that made her question her first impression, after a week of prayerful consideration decided to remove her name, deeming it was not a "good fit". It is hard to be rejected and disconcerting to think our second impression undid our first, but sadly, this is what happened.

On the Sunday following her decision I spoke with a member of council after worship as you gathered in the Welcome Area for fellowship. There was palpable excitement as voices chattered, laughter rang out, I said, "we need to make sure the next candidate sees this too: the warmth, the vitality, the joy!" So, as we look ahead, let's be honest and self-reflective about what she saw. Let's resolve to do better and remain faithful! Remember that "outside eyes", even if we think they are not correct, are the eyes with which others see us, so we should prayerfully and ask, "did they see the truth?" On a more positive note, July 2 and 9 a Summer Adult Education series "Lutheranism 101" continues in the community room at 9:15 a.m. A second council listening post is scheduled for July 16 at 9:15 a.m. in the community room to discuss the 5th strategic goal, to expand our physical facilities to include a multi-purpose building, and July 23 the Abiding Christ Praise Team travel comes to lead us in worship at the 10:30 hour. Resolve to attend all these events.

On the first weekend of August, we celebrate a Homecoming, first by hosting a Classic Car Show on Saturday the 5th from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. in the back parking lot and then on Sunday the 6th, inviting former members and families to return for a time of worship and fellowship. Worship that day is followed by a meal (an outdoor pizza oven will be here to provide the food), live entertainment and historic displays throughout the building celebrating our 65 years as a parish. If you have memorabilia or photos you would be willing to share, bring them to the church office before the end of July, we will have them put on display for that weekend.
