Personal Care Kit Shopping List

*1 light-weight bath towel (52" x 27"), dark color recommended

(make sure you check the size on the tag)

- *2-3 bath-size bars of soap totaling 8-9 ounces
- *1 adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging
- *1 sturdy comb (no picks or fine-toothed combs)
- *1 metal nail clipper (attached file optional)

Place all items in a plastic grocery bag and secure it so small items do not fall out.

Council made some excellent progress and we will be sharing the results with you soon.

At the beginning of the meeting, Pastor Peter shared with Council that he has been in touch with the Assistant to the Bishop, Pastor Bob Abrams, with regard to our search for a new pastor. Pastor Bob has shared that there has been a slight uptick in contacts with the Synod from pastors who are interested in moving to a different church. Keep our search for a new pastor in your prayers.

Council also approved a budget for our Newcomer Contact Task Force and gave their approval to a request from Betty Lou Johansen to purchase a memorial bench commemorating Pr. John Johansen using some of the Memorial money that has been sent in his name to Good Shepherd.



Activity Room remodel- The old cabinets need to be emptied and removed before Dave Stein can install the new ones. Diana offered to organize Plarners to help relocate contents of the cabinets this week.

Committee Reports:

Worship: The Chancel Choir will have their first practice on Sunday, September 11, at 10:15 a.m. We always welcome new members. The Bell choir is still in need of one more ringer. We will start practice in August. Marsha Fischbach, Director will play instead of direct until we find another person to ring bells. We will have a worship committee meeting in August to plan for Fall and the Christmas season.

<u>Mission/Outreach/LSIM/MUCC</u>: First Lutheran in Xenia joined LSIM in July. Pr. Prill was elected president of LSIM.

<u>Property:</u> Les Barker will finish the fence in the next two weeks. Trying to pull together a crew to get it stretched. Dave Stein plans on finishing a job he is working on and then getting the cabinets installed. Work day went well: got the tree down and flower beds cleaned up. Still working on an electrical issue.
