REMEMBER FREE MONEY!!!

There are several organizations that are willing to give us money if we just take the time to get things set up. This article hopes to remind us all of what is available.

Probably the rebate program with the most potential is one that many of us are now using on a regular basis. How many of you do your online shopping with Amazon? This is to remind you to make the switch to Amazon Smile before you shop.



It takes just a couple of minutes to arrange it. Go to smile.amazon.com and set it up. The toughest part is finding Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, West Milton on the list of eligible non-profits. There were something like twelve pages of eligible Good Shepherds and our Good Shepherd was on the 9th or 10th page. Don't give up – it's there.

Once you designate our church as your charity of choice, you need to access Amazon via the smile.amazon.com website. You can make that website a "favorite" making it easier to access each time. Once there, everything looks exactly the same as if you went via amazon.com. All your preference lists, buying history, prior history, etc. are there. The only difference is now when you buy something, Amazon will send us money!! They donate .05% of whatever you buy to our church.



And don't forget the Kroger rebates! Good Shepherd Lutheran is getting close to \$300 a year because some of our members took the time to sign up for the rebates on the Kroger website. Anytime they shop at Kroger now, Kroger sends us money! Tapping into free money is a no brainer.

Finally, our local IGA also has a program that will send us a rebate at the end of the year. Just bring your IGA receipts to church and deposit them in the box for IGA receipts. At the end of the year we will total them up and we'll get a check.

From Pr. Emeritus John Johansen -

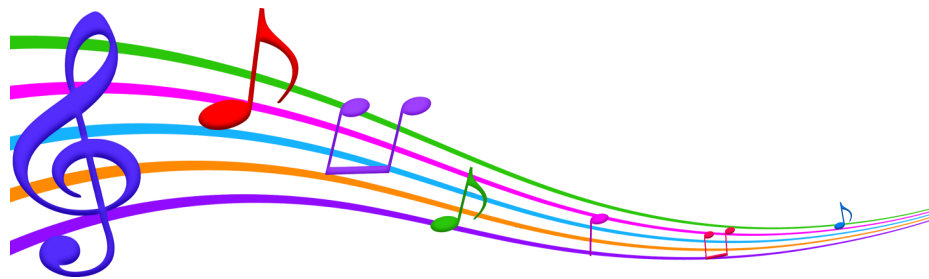

A practice schedule will be available at our first practice.

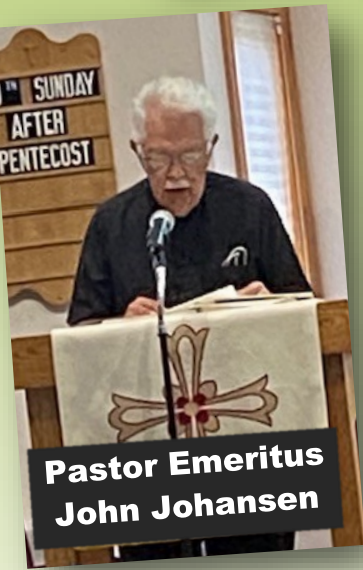

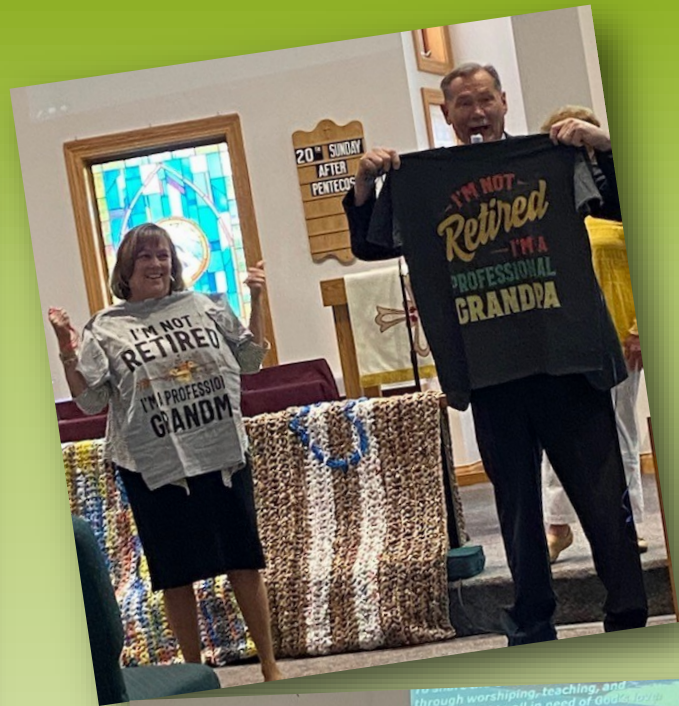
