Financial Secretary's Report: Motion to approve as written: Diana Frye, Second: Les Barker. All were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Motion to approve as written: Toby Theis, Second: Suzie Vagedes. All were in favor.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Peter challenged all present to be creative and put our heads together to come up with a vision and a 5-year plan for Good Shepherd Lutheran Church to grow and thrive into the next generation and beyond!

NEW BUSINESS:

Memorial bench – Betty Lou would like a Memorial bench placed in the green area facing the portico in honor of Pastor John using the memorial funds donated in his name. Jerry Bonner offered to help pour the slab on which the bench would sit.

Committee Reports:

Worship: Meeting has been slated for September 4

Mission/Outreach/LSIM/MUCC: Suzie Vagedes presented ideas for promotional items to be distributed during out-reach events. Items included mugs, travel mugs, water bottles and magnets with Good Shepherd's logo and info. Each item also had an uplifting message. Suzie asked for guidance and funds to buy these. After Council discussion, Diana Frye moved to re-purpose the approximately \$900 of Guiding Light money (as Guiding Light was no longer active) to use for the purchase of the above promotional items for Mission Outreach, Les Barker seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed.

LSIM: Diana Frye brought an outdated Good Shepherd pamphlet from the LSIM meeting and asked for input on updating the information. Suzie Vagedes offered to help her with this. Property: Les Barker finished the fence. Dave Stein is working on getting the cabinets installed. Still working on an electrical issue.

Youth/Christian Education/Preschool: Youth/Christian Ed./Preschool: Preschool classes are full with a waiting list. Board voted to give the teachers a \$.50/hour pay increase and director a pay increase of \$50/month. The fence is up and the Playground will be coming in November as of our last update. Becky held an open house this morning which was a huge success. Aug 29th is 1st day of school. Sept 12th is Grandparent's day. October Pumpkins and Trunk or Treat are being planned- Date to be announced. Stewardship and Fellowship: no reports.
